Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (CA), Washington and Oregon state-approved Direct Transfer degrees or other state's equivalent transfer certification prior to the student being admitted, enrolled and attending his/her first session in a bachelor's degree program at University of Massachusetts Global satisfies all University of Massachusetts Global General Education requirements except LBSU 302 & 304. Students who matriculate to University of Massachusetts Global with partial General Education certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category. ## **Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives**

BA Applied Studies consists of 15 credits in foundation courses and 21 credits of courses in a selected area of emphasis to fulfill the 36 credit requirement for the program.

Students may choose from the following emphases:

- 1. Applied Communication
- 2. Applied Humanities
- 3. Leadership

It is possible for transfer courses to meet course requirements within the emphasis area. That coursework must be reviewed by a dean within the School of Arts and Sciences to determine transferability.

\*Minimum of 30 credits completed in residence at University of Massachusetts Global; 18 of which must be upper-division credits, 12 of which must be in the student's major.
