The following information is a guide of courses that transfer to University of Massachusetts Global to fulfill general education requirements and Business Administration major requirements in the Competency-Based program.

Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (CA), Washington and Oregon state-approved Direct Transfer degrees or other state's equivalent transfer certification prior to the student being admitted, enrolled and attending his/her first session in a bachelor's degree program at University of Massachusetts Global satisfies all University of Massachusetts Global General Education requirements except competency LBSC 320 & LBSC 321. Students who matriculate to University of Massachusetts Global with partial General Education certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.
