The following information is a guide of courses that transfer to University of Massachusetts Global to fulfill general education requirements and Information Technology major requirements in the Competency-Based program.

Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (A.A.012 Tech 002) at Mt. San Jacinto College first session in a Global satisfies all University of Massachusetts Global General Education requirements except competency LBSC 320 & LBSC 321. Students who matriculate to University of Massachusetts Global with partial General Education certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.
