Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives

BA Organizational Leadership consists of 15 credits in foundation courses, 12 credits in competencies and 18 credits (9 Upper-Division) in electives or courses in a selected area of emphasis to fulfill the 48 credit requirement for the program. Students may choose from the following emphases:

1. Organizational Administration
2. Supply Chains Systems

Students may choose the elective credits from the following areas of study:

Organizational Leadership, Human Resources, Criminal Justice, Organizational Administration, Business Administration (to include courses from Accounting, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Information Systems Management, Marketing, and Management).
